


'Plunder of the Commons': Free Community Seminar

Presented by Professor Guy Standing, best-selling author of Plunder of the Commons: A Manifesto for Sharing Public Wealth and The Precariat: The New Dangerous Class.



Professor Standing's latest book Plunder of the Commons questions the commodification of our shared wealth, from the air we breathe, to the water we drink to the public spaces we all use. Guy's talk will address these themes and outline a future vision and practical steps on how we might collectively reclaim and expand the Commons for present and future generations.
