8.30am - 5pm - 7pm

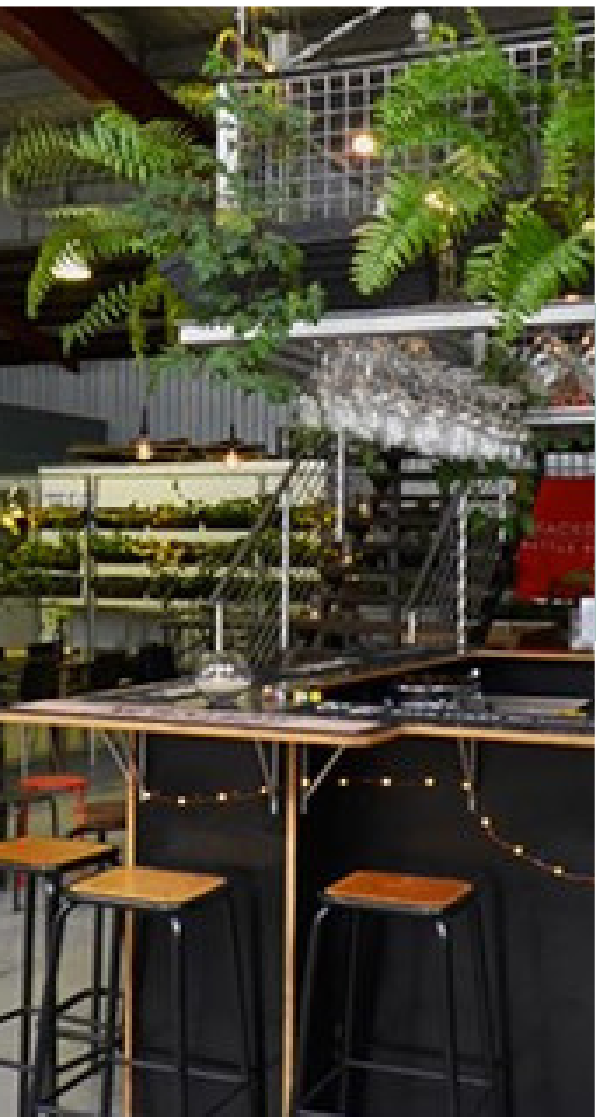
