An Associate Professor of Human Resource Management and Public Policy at Leeds University Business School, Dr Ingold's academic specialism lies at the intersection of human resource management and public policy.

Her research and publications cover active labour market programmes in comparative context; disadvantaged labour market groups including parents/carers and disabled people; recruitment and selection; workplace inclusion; and evidence and policy-making.

She has a background in the voluntary sector and in policy, research and people development in central government and has published in a range of topranked academic journals.

Dr Ingold was awarded an ESRC Future Research Leaders Fellowship and won the Ken Young Prize for the best article in Policy & Politics.

She is a member of the Editorial Board of the leading sociology of work journal, Work, Employment and Society.
